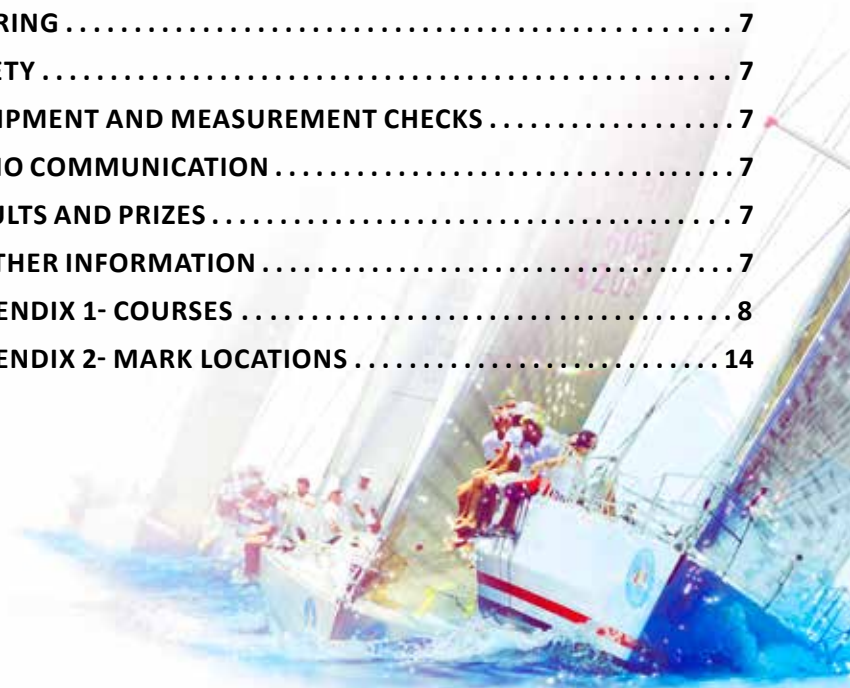

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Organising Authority is the Antigua Sailing Week Committee affiliated with the Antigua Sailing Association. The Regatta headquarters will be located at Antigua Yacht Club, Falmouth Harbour, Antigua. Times are Antigua Standard Time (UTC minus 4 hours).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 – 2016*.
- 1.2 The Regatta will also be governed by:
 - (a) for boats in CSA classes, *the CSA Rating Rule*;
 - (b) for boats in Bareboat classes, *the Requirements for Bareboat Class*;
 - (c) for multihulls, *the CSA Multihull Rating Rule*;
 - (d) for all boat s, *the ASW Minimum Safety Rules*.
- 1.3 Rule 52, Manual Power, shall not apply.
- 1.4 Rule 55, Trash Disposal, shall be amended by adding at the end: 'However, discarding biodegradable, environmentally friendly bands when setting a sail is permitted.'
- 1.5 Rule 77, Identification on Sails, shall not apply but competitors must comply with Sailing Instructions 8.3 and 8.4.
- 1.6 For Multihull classes, ASW Minimum Safety Rule #2 with respect to lifelines shall not apply.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority as permitted by ISAF Regulation 20.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 3.1 All notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board located near the Committee Desk at Antigua Yacht Club.

4. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 Any change to these Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Notice Board at Antigua Yacht Club before 8:00 am on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 8:00 pm on the day before it will take effect.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from a flag staff on the lawn at Antigua Yacht Club.

6. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 Racing shall take place on:
Sunday, April 26;
Monday, April 27;
Tuesday, April 28;
Thursday, April 30; and
Friday, May 1.
- 6.2 All classes will race a maximum of two (2) races on each day.

- 6.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 10:00 am. The order of starts for the first race each day for each start area will be posted on the official notice board prior to 4:00 pm on Saturday, April 25, 2015.
- 6.4 Committee Boat A will be stationed at the Windward start/finish line on each of Sunday, April 26, Tuesday, April 28 and Friday, May 1, 2015. On Monday, April 27 and Thursday, April 30, Committee Boat A will be stationed at the Rendezvous start/finish line.
- 6.5 Committee Boat B will be stationed at the Rendezvous start/finish line on each of Sunday, April 26, Tuesday, April 28 and Friday, May 1, 2015. On Monday, April 27 and Thursday, April 30, Committee Boat B will be stationed at the Windward start/finish line.

7. CLASSES

- 7.1 Classes will be divided by type of boat and/or time correction factor (TCF) at the sole discretion of the Race Committee which may decide that in certain classes boats must sail with their spinnaker rating.
- 7.2 Each class will be assigned to either Committee Boat A or Committee Boat B for the duration of the Regatta. A list of classes, the Committee Boat to which they are assigned and the start area for each Committee Boat for each day will be posted prior to registration and distributed with the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.3 Boats must declare their intended sail configuration at Registration which must not be changed after Noon on Saturday, April 25, 2015 for the duration of the Regatta. This also applies to boats with alternate headsail ratings.

8. CLASS FLAGS AND IDENTIFICATION

- 8.1 Class flags will be issued to each boat at Registration. The list of class flags will form part of these Sailing Instructions.
- 8.2 Class flags must be flown from the backstay or, if that is not possible, from another prominent position on the boat.
- 8.3 All boats with sail numbers must display them while racing and will not be required to display tie-on identification numbers. Sail numbers must be provided at Registration.
- 8.4 All boats without sail numbers will be provided with identification numbers at Registration which shall be clearly displayed on both sides of the forward and aft lifelines of the boat at all times during the Regatta. Alleged violation of this Sailing Instruction shall not be grounds for protest by another boat. This changes rule 60.1.

9. COURSES

- 9.1 Appendix 1 to these Sailing Instructions describes the marks to be passed, their order and the side on which each mark is to be left. The diagram in Appendix 1 shows the names and approximate locations of the marks and is provided as an aid only.
- 9.2 The number of the course to be sailed for each race will be announced on the designated VHF channel for each Committee Boat and will be indicated by a numeral representing the course number on a white sign board to be mounted on the aft portion of the Committee Boat at the warning signal of each class.
- 9.3 While racing no boat shall sail to the north of any part of Cades Reef. Boats entering this prohibited zone are subject to protest and disqualification.

10. MARKS

- 10.1 The starting marks will be orange inflatable buoys. The finishing marks will be yellow inflatable buoys.
- 10.2 All other marks of the course will be orange inflatable buoys except that the Shirley South (SS) mark and the Carlisle (Z) mark will be yellow inflatable buoys. Some marks may display advertising.

- 10.3 Mark locations, approximate GPS coordinates and designated identifying letters are as described in Appendix 2 to these Sailing Instructions.

11. THE START

- 11.1 The starting line will be between a staff on the Committee Boat displaying an orange flag and a nearby orange inflatable buoy.
- 11.2 The location of the starting line for all races will be as described in Appendix 1 to these Sailing Instructions.
- 11.3 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall keep clear of boats racing. Alleged violation of this Sailing Instruction will only be grounds for protest by the Race Committee. This changes Rule 60.1 and Rule 62.1.
- 11.4 A boat starting later than fifteen (15) minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing. This changes rule A5.

12. THE FINISH

- 12.1 The finishing line will be between an orange flag on the Committee Boat displaying a blue flag and a nearby yellow inflatable buoy.
- 12.2 If the Race Committee intends to start an additional race it will display the Second Substitute flag with no sound signal while boats are finishing. The second race of the day for each class may be started as soon as possible after all boats in a class have finished the first race. Start times for the second race of a day will be announced on the designated VHF channel for each Committee Boat.

13. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 13.1 For all classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 13.2 Except for breaches of Parts 1 and 2 of the Rules, the International Jury may apply any penalty that it deems equitable. This changes rule 64.1.
- 13.3 A boat that does not take a penalty in accordance with rules 44.1 and 44.2 may accept a forty per cent (40%) scoring penalty before the protest hearing at the discretion of the International Jury. This changes rules 44.3(c) and A4.2.

14. TIME LIMITS

- 14.1 The time limit for all classes on each day will be 5:00 pm except that on Friday, May 1, the time limit will be 4:00 pm.
- 14.2 For classes having more than one (1) race in a day, the time limit for the first race of the day will be one (1) hour after the first boat in the class finishes.
- 14.3 Boats failing to finish by the time limit will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes rules 35, A4 and A5.

15. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 15.1 A boat that intends to protest shall endeavor to notify the Committee Boat after finishing on its designated VHF channel.
- 15.2 The protest time limit will be one (1) hour after the Committee Boat for the protesting boat docks.
- 15.3 The time limit for filing a written request for a hearing under rule N1.4(b) is thirty (30) minutes after a party has been notified of the panel's decision.
- 15.4 On the last day of racing a request for redress based on a Jury's decision shall be filed no later than thirty (30) minutes after a party has been notified of the Jury's decision. This changes rule 62.2.
- 15.5 Notices informing competitors of the place and approximate time of each protest hearing will be posted on the Protest Board adjacent to the Protest Desk and hearings will commence as soon as possible after these notices have been displayed.

15.6 For protests involving an alleged breach of a rule of Part 2, a short arbitration hearing may be held prior to a protest hearing. After arbitration and prior to a Jury hearing, any party to arbitration may accept a forty per cent (40%) scoring penalty. Rules for arbitration will be posted at the Protest Desk.

15.7 Except as allowed in section 2.2 of the CSA Rating Rule, no measurement or rating protest will be accepted after 6:00 pm on Tuesday, April 28, 2015.

16. SCORING

16.1 A boat's series score will be:

- (a) when fewer than six (6) races have been completed, the total of her race scores;
- (b) when six (6) or more races have been completed, the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

16.2 For all classes, one (1) race shall constitute a series.

16.3 Application of handicaps will be made on a time-on-time basis.

17. SAFETY

17.1 No boat shall race with an anchor overhanging the bow. However, written application may be made to the Race Committee for exemption from this requirement and the associated portion of ASW Safety Rule #6 which may, in its sole discretion, grant exemption.

17.2 A boat that retires shall attempt to notify the Race Committee as soon as possible by calling the appropriate Committee Boat on the applicable VHF channel, and shall use its best efforts to receive an acknowledgment.

18. EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

18.1 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time, including on the water, for compliance with the CSA Rating Rule, the ASW Minimum Safety Rules and these Sailing Instructions.

19. RADIO COMMUNICATION

19.1 The Race Committee may broadcast the following information:

- (a) time checks before the first start of each day;
- (b) the courses to be sailed for each class;
- (c) notification of amendments to the Sailing Instructions;
- (d) the abandonment or postponement of any race.

19.2 Failure of a boat to hear any notification on the VHF radio will not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a).

19.3 Committee Boat A will stand by on VHF Channel 17. Committee Boat B will stand by on VHF Channel 77.

20. RESULTS AND PRIZES

20.1 Results will be posted on the results boards at Antigua Yacht Club and at www.sailingweek.com as soon as possible after each race. Results may also be posted on large screen TVs in bars and restaurants throughout the English and Falmouth Harbour areas.

20.2 Details of overall Regatta prizes will be included in the Registration package.

20.3 There will be a daily prize-giving held at Antigua Yacht Club at 5:00 pm on each day of racing, except that on Friday, May 1 it will be held at 4:00 pm.

20.4 All overall Regatta prizes will be presented at the final awards presentation to be held in Nelson's Dockyard at approximately 7:00 pm on Friday, May 1, 2015.
