## **COMMITTEE DESK**

The Committee Desk and Protest Desk will be located at Antigua Yacht Club for the duration of the Regatta and will monitor VHF Channel 12. The Committee Desk will be open daily from 8 am to 6 pm except for Lay Day when it will be open 10 am to 12 pm and Saturday, April 30 when it will be open 10 am to 1 pm. Registration will be Friday. April 22 from 9 am to 5 pm and Saturday, April 23 from 9 am to 12 pm.

## **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE**

ABSAR (Antigua Barbuda Search and Rescue) has two safety boats on the water with paramedic on board during all racing and can be reached on VHF Channel 16. It also has a medic clinic located at Antiqua Yacht Club Marina Resort, ABSAR is a charitable organisation providing essential safety and medical services free of charge. Please donate generously should you make use of ABSAR's services (or even if you don't!) — either on the water or on shore.

## **WATCHING THE RACES**

All race courses will be off the south coast of Antiqua. On each day of racing some boats will sail from Windward Beach to the east and others will sail from Rendezvous Bay to the west. There will be excellent spectating opportunities from vantage points all along the south coast and in particular from Shirley Heights, the Blockhouse. Fort Charlotte, Windward Beach, Rendezvous Beach, Carlisle Bay, Morris Bay and from various trails along the south coast. On English Harbour Race Day, Sunday April 24, you can get up close and experience the racing on the water on the Half Moon Bay spectator boats. Tickets are available in advance only for \$70 usd.
